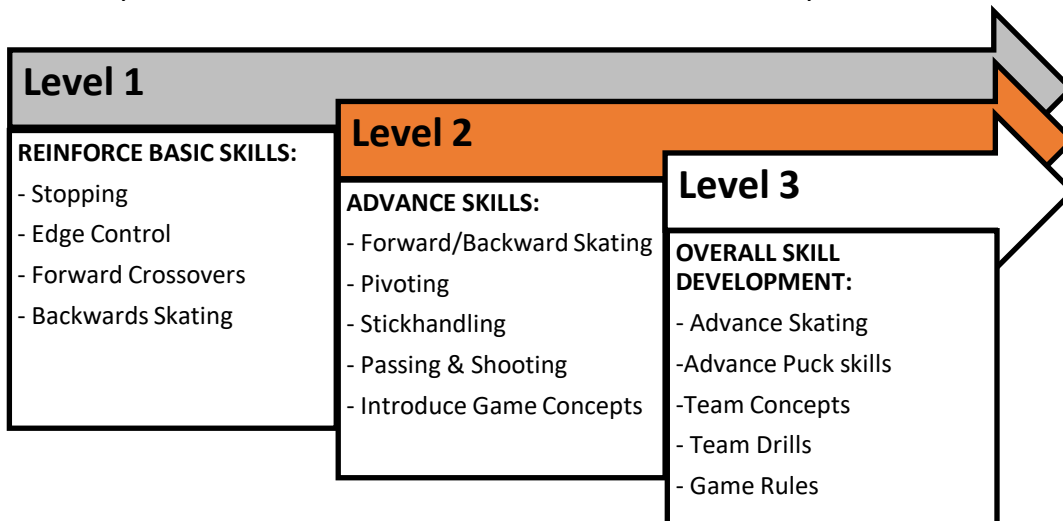


LEARN TO PLAY PROGRAM – SEASON OVERVIEW

The Snider Hockey Learn to Play (LTP) Program is designed to build upon our SPARKS curriculum by continuing with on-ice skill progression while providing students with structured academic support and life skills activities to further their overall development.

Learn to Play (LTP) Curriculum

The Snider Hockey Learn to Play Program is offered year-round from September to June. The LTP Program is split into three levels with each level typically taking 4 weeks to complete, however, keep in mind that each student develops their skills at a different pace and won't move up to the next level until they are ready to do so. Below is an overview of our 3 Learn to Play levels:



Snider Hockey League (SHL)

When students reach the Snider Hockey League (SHL) they will be eligible to participate in competitive weekend games with students from other Snider Hockey rinks! SHL practices and skill clinics run year-round from September to June with games taking place from November to March.
