Frequently Asked Questions

Am I eligible to be a Junior Coach?

- Snider students may apply to be a Junior Coach if they are active within the organization, are in 9th - 12th grade, and have completed at least one full season in the SHL or are a member of a Snider travel team.

What are the time requirements to Junior Coach?

- Junior Coaches are required to volunteer a minimum of two hours per month.

What if there are certain weeks or months I can't coach?

- Scheduling is flexible based on individual availability - a Junior Coach can select which months they are available to coach during the season. Junior Coaches are also permitted to take time off as needed with advanced communication to Coach Anne.

How does scheduling work?

- A weekly scheduling form is distributed to Junior Coaches to select their preferred practice times, locations, and days of the week.

Do my volunteer hours count for school?

- Yes! Coach Anne keeps track of each Junior Coach's completed hours so they can be submitted for school or added to your resume.

How do I apply?

- Applications open at the beginning of each after-school season. Outreach with the application link is sent to active Snider high school students each September.
